Employees of AnazaoHealth,

It is conceivable that government officials may soon issue an Executive Order instructing the quarantine of Florida residents and/or the closure of nonessential Florida businesses to limit the spread of COVID-19. Based on our review of recent statements made by the President, the CDC, FDA, and leaders of states who have implemented similar policies, we are confident that pharmaceutical manufacturers, pharmaceutical wholesalers and distributors, outsourcing facilities, and pharmacies are considered to be essential businesses that will be allowed to continue to operate following an Executive Order to quarantine and/or close nonessential businesses. This exact thing has already occurred in other states. For example, the following was communicated by the Governor of Nevada on Wednesday:

“Only essential services should remain open — such as fire, police, transit, and health care services, in addition to businesses that provide food, shelter, or social services for disadvantaged populations.”

“Non-essential services such as beauty shops, barbershops, and nail, tanning, and waxing salons should close until further notice.”

“Only essential businesses should remain open such as pharmacies, grocery stores, drug and convenience stores, banks and financial institutions, hardware stores, and gas stations. I am asking grocery stores consider special hours for the vulnerable populations.”

Though we do not yet have specific information from our government officials, we are anticipating some sort of Executive Order. As you know, we are a pharmacy that prepares and distributes essential medications for hospitals, clinics and other care centers, and dispenses essential medications to patients across the country. In this global pandemic, services and medications provided by AnazaoHealth are essential for practitioners and patients seeking a full arsenal of opportunities to fight exposure to and/or symptoms of COVID-19.

For the above reasons, we fully anticipate that we will be allowed to continue to operate and assist healthcare practitioners in the fight against COVID-19. In the event of an Executive Order, you should be allowed to go to work at AnazaoHealth.

Accordingly, to National Guard, law enforcement, or similar personnel: The holder of this letter is a mission-critical leader, employee, contractor or vendor tasked with the provision of vital services for AnazaoHealth, to continue to distribute active pharmaceutical ingredients and excipients in emergency response to address the COVID-19 pandemic and related medication needs of medical practitioners and patients. These support services are critical to the health and wellbeing of patients. Please allow for passage of this person, property and/or equipment to support this essential operation. We request that this individual be permitted passage without delay or hindrance and, in case of need, to give all lawful aid and protection to them as a support for critical infrastructure of the community and nation.

As mentioned in prior instructions from the company, for the health and safety of our employees and community, employees experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19, including a fever or respiratory illness, should stay away from work in accordance with company policies.
